- ~ Earlier this year, the California governor signed a bill **allotting 50% of UC spots to be transfer students from community.**This means **less spots for qualified high school seniors.**
- ~ Private, for-profit colleges account for roughly **11% of the student population**,

but account for nearly 50% of the total student debt.


